Remembrance Day Ceremony will commence at 10.40am, please be seated by 10.30am. Parents are welcome to attend the ceremony at Port Curtis Road.

Remembrance Day 11th November every year marks the anniversary of the armistice which ended the First World War 1914–18. We are a very proud school and community that celebrate Remembrance Day every year.

Remembrance Day is a day to reflect and remember all the servicemen and servicewomen who have served our country "then and now".

We celebrate their sacrifices so that we are able to live our lives as we do today.

We highlight the continuing tradition of commemorating Remembrance Day on the anniversary of the original Gallipoli landing.

This year is not only the 95th anniversary of the armistice on 11 November which ended the First World War, but also the 20th anniversary of the internment of the Unknown Australian Soldier in the Australian War Memorial's Hall of Memory. Our Year 7 students will be reading the **PLEDGE OF REMEMBRANCE** to show respect to the unknown soldiers. Also this year we commemorate the armistice of the Korean War in 1953.

Our ceremony will be finished around 11.00am. Poppies and badges on sale for \$0.50 on Monday.

What is eKindy?
A flexible 'at home' kindergarten program ...
with online support from qualified teachers ...
equivalent to a centre-based program.

What does it cost?
There are **no fees*** for families who meet the eligibility criteria.
* eKindy places are funded through a National-State government agreement.

Is my child eligible?
You can register for eKindy if:

1. your child turns **4 by June 30** in their kindy year
2. your child/a parent is an **Australian citizen or permanent resident** of Australia
3. you fit one of the following categories.
 - Distance – live at least 16 km from the nearest centre-based service
 - Medical – due to a medical condition your child is unable to attend a centre-based service (medical certificate required)
 - Travelling/itinerant lifestyle – your child will be away from their principal place of residence for 10 weeks or their residence will change at least twice.
