

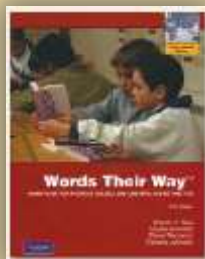
Our Values and Beliefs about Literacy.

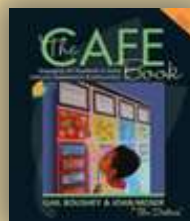
